Pastoral Statement for dispensation from fasting during Chinese New Year 2025

Dear People of God,

This year, the Lunar / Chinese New Year falls on 29 January 2025, and most Chinese celebrate the event for fifteen days, ending 12 February 2025.

The Catholic Bishops Conference of Malaysia, Singapore and Brunei, in consultation with the Episcopal Regional Liturgy Commission of Malaysia, Singapore and Brunei offer the following guidance:

- (1) That the Fridays of January 31, 2025 and February 7, 2025, dispensation is given from abstinence.
- (2) That the faithful substitute these days with other forms of penance, especially works of charity and exercises of piety during this Year of Jubilee.

Wishing you the Lord's abundant blessings and joyous celebration of the Chinese New Year.





<u>BAPTISM OF BABIES</u> is conducted in English or Bahasa Malaysia in the Cathedral. Parents with babies to be baptised are to register online at https://formfaca.de/sm/y2oT0Qf_P and upload the scanned copy of all the required documents stipulated below:

Only Parents who have submitted complete set of the required documents will be accepted and the Parish Office will inform you when and where to attend the Rite of Baptism in due course. You will then be required to send in your original Family Record Book for updating before the actual rite.

According to Canon Law # 874, a Sponsor (Godparent) must be a baptised, confirmed and practising Catholic. If married, his / her marriage must already be blessed in the Catholic Church. (This does not apply to those who were not Catholics [both husband & wife] at the time of their civil marriage).
